Country and Committee Assignments

Country and committee assignments will be sent via email by March 20, 2016. Please fill out the country and committee preferences section on the Eventbrite registration form. In order to maximize your school's chances of receiving a requested country, please register and send the payment (if paying by check) as soon as possible. Please continue checking our website for updates.

Research

*Laptops, pre-written resolutions, and laminates will absolutely **not** be permitted in committee in order to guarantee all delegates a fair chance of winning awards. Delegates in possession of prohibited items are subject to disqualification and dismissal.*

Position Papers

Position papers are required to be eligible for awards. If a delegate's paper is submitted by Saturday, April 30, 2016 at 11:59 PM PST, he or she will be eligible for all awards and their paper will be graded and returned to the delegate. If a delegate's paper is submitted by Saturday, May 14, 2016 at 11:59 PM PST, he or she will only be eligible for committee awards. Delegates will not be eligible for awards for positions papers submitted after May 14, and position papers submitted after April 30 will not be returned with a grade unless requested. Position papers must be submitted via email to the head chair of each committee, and the appropriate email addresses are posted on our website.
